Welcome to the start of a very exciting year for everyone at CtS. We hope you all had a restful summer and are enjoying the new year. Both classes have made fantastic starts and all the adults are looking forward to all the exciting learning we will be doing this term. Our topic this half term will be 'What Have the Romans Done For us?' followed by 'Beyond the Lamppost' in the second half. We have also started learning about our year group value. Year 4 have been becoming experts in compassion. We will continue to focus on these values throughout the year, growing and becoming leaders in this value.

<u>English</u>

In English we will be writing a newspaper report about Boudicca's rebellion which will link to our history work about the Romans. After that we will be looking at persuasive writing.

After half term we will be looking at fiction and writing a voyage and return story based on 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe.' We will also be writing character descriptions using a range of descriptive devices.

Our topics

What Have the Romans Done for Us? <u>History</u> We will be studying the Romans in Britain and the key changes over that time.

We will be exploring how Hindus express their beliefs through a range of deities and symbols. <u>Art</u>
