Happy New Year from the Foundation team, we hope you all had a relaxing break with your family making memories and enjoying spending time together. It has been lovely to see the children returning with smiles on heir faces ready for the term ahead. We are welcoming some new members to our Foundation team this term, Mrs Walker, Mrs Reynolds and Mrs Read. This is because our Nursery has grown since last term and we would like to send a warm welcome to our new parents.

This half term, our topic is called, 'Buildings and Transport' where we will learn all about the environment which we live in and how we can get travel to different places in a town, city and across the world. The children will be continuing their exploration through play and will be able to watch the effect of the seasons changing as the term goes on. We will be encouraging the children to use new vocabulary they have learnt and begin to articulate their ideas, thoughts in full sentences with connectives and model this in our day to day interactions.

We will be teaching Phonics in our Read Write Inc. sessions daily, so please ensure you read your children's books with them daily to consolidate any learning taken place that day. It is important that Home Learning books are sent in weekly to ensure your child has an opportunity to complete it in time. Spring term is the time for us to drive their learning to prepare them for their final term in Foundation and to make sure that we take every learning opportunity. Remember to share books with your child to develop a love for reading. If you have any questions or would like to discuss anything please feel free to approach one of the adults on the gate and they will happy to help.
