On Thursday, Miss Christian and I took our Year 6 'Scholars' to the Courtauld Institute of Art in Central London. The Scholar's Programme is a hugely prestigious programme for 14 of our most able pupils in Year 6. It is aimed at pupils who have the potential to study at a competitive university later in their education, but who would be the first person in their family to do so, for a variety of reasons.



Our Scholars will be undertaking a course on the History of Art, and they were greatly inspired by the launch trip, which not only gave them a taster of the course, but also taught them all about university life, the types of courses that you could study, and how it can lead to exciting career opportunities. They also had campus tours, an interview with the Vice-Dean and the opportunity to ask questions

of the undergraduate students. Their PhD Art History tutor, will now visit them in school and they will complete their course over the next term. We cannot wait to see the results when they undertake their final written assignments!

Also this week, we were visited by the Director of Education for the ODBST, Jan Martin. She undertook a SEND review alongside the SLT. During the visit, she visited lessons, did a book review, spoke to staff and scrutinised documents with leaders. Our SEND provision was judged to be good and although we know that we can always continue to improve, we were thrilled that the huge amount of work that has been put in by Mrs Summerfield and our teaching staff was recognised. We really do have an incredible team here at CTS and everyone shares the same belief: that EVERY single child is capable of achieving their full potential.
