## This Week's Inspection

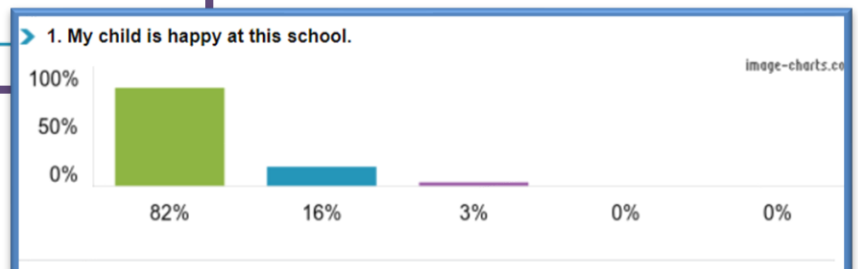
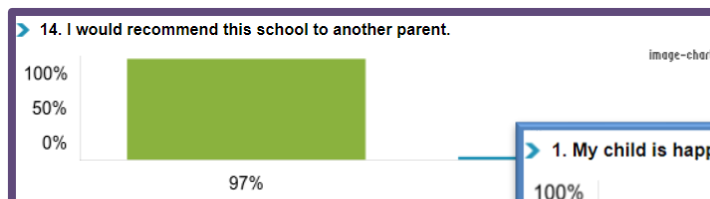


The inspection team spent two days looking into every aspect of our school. The first day was taken up with curriculum 'Deep Dives' where they took a really in depth look into 5 of our curriculum subjects. The subjects chosen were: Early Reading, Maths, DT, French and PE. They observed lessons in all classes from Year N to Year 6 and spoke to children, staff and looked in books to assess how effective our curriculum offer is.

On the second day they looked in depth at the other areas of the Ofsted Framework and made judgements on the quality of Behaviour, Attitudes to Learning, Attendance, Personal Development, Leadership and Management, SEN and Governance. We had representation from our Governing body, from Trustees and from the Central team of the ODBST.

We had such amazingly positive feedback from parents, that I wanted to share a couple of the results with you as they were so incredible that they also impressed OFSTED! 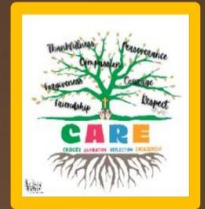
