- Adding items that students are required to wear or have.
- Changing the logo.
- Making any items "optional".

Maisies requires written details to be submitted to via email by 31st January 2025 at lisa@maisies-superstore.co.uk We will not be accepting or implementing, in any circumstance, requests for changes and additions which are made after the deadline outlined above.

Maisies will be closed every Wednesday from 6th November 2024 until Spring 2025.
