Maisies contractual period for being able to change your school’s uniform and P.E. kit policy is between now until the end of January 2025. Please note that this includes:

- Changing the types of items which students are required to wear or have.
- Adding items that students are required to wear or have.
- Changing the logo.
- Making any items "optional".
