

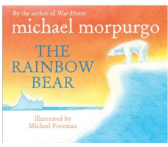

English

P.E

Personal, Social, Health and Emotional Development

The units we will be covering this term are Families and Friendships, Safe Relationships and Respecting ourselves and others. **Life skills**— please practise at home: closing up buttons and tying laces. We will also be practising at school.

Home Learning

We ask all children to complete the following tasks each week:

- **Reading** - Children should aim to read for five minutes every day and log this in their reading journals. Twice a week, children should complete a longer response to their reading. Please ensure reading books and diaries are in school everyday to be checked and read with by an adult.
- **Spellings** - Children will receive new spelling lists on a Friday to take home and learn. These will be tested on the following Friday.
- **Fluency targets** - Please practise these at home every week ready for the quiz on Fridays.

Library

Library day for Acorn will be on Thursdays, please could all children bring their library books in to be able to change them.

Art/DI

Mathematics

In Maths, we will begin by focussing on number and place value extending our knowledge of numbers to 100, before moving onto addition and subtraction then shape. Please work weekly with your child to learn timetables of 2, 5 and 10 as well as practising their fluency targets as being able to recall these facts instantly will benefit them greatly.

Fluency target this term:

- To know number bonds to 20
- To know number bonds of 10 up to 100.
- To know by heart doubles of numbers.

Religious Education

The overarching key question for the first half term is: 'How do Christians find out what God is like?' In Autumn 2, we will explore the question: 'Why do many Christians meet together regularly and what do they do?'

Science

Over the term, we will be learning about Everyday Materials and their properties. Specifically, exploring buildings to work scientifically to test materials.
