



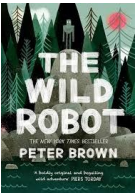
Sycamore

This year, Year 4 will be known as Sycamore class; Miss Casey is the Year 4 class teacher and Mrs Thomson will be supporting in class too.

We hope that your child is settling back in well and has enjoyed our first few days. Please do let us know if there is anything we can do to support your child.

This term we will be learning about all things Italy. In the first half of the term, our humanities topic will be Geography based as we explore the human and physical geography of Italy as well as its culture and customs. In the second half the term, we will move on to learning about the Roman Empire and, in particular, its impact on modern Britain.

English



In the first half term, we will be looking at the book *The Wild Robot* and will be writing a diary entry from the perspective of a character.

After half term, we will be continuing to look at the book *The Wild Robot* however we will be writing a narrative extract.

Home Learning

We ask all children to complete the following tasks each week:

- **Reading** - Children should aim to read at least five times per week and log a written response to what they have read in their reading diaries.
- **Times tables** - Children should complete their 5 weekly garage games on Times Table Rockstars and practice their Times Tables weekly on Soundcheck.
- **Maths and English** - On a Friday, children will be bringing home a Maths/English homework sheet in their homework folders. This should be completed and returned by Thursday the following week.
- **Spellings** - Children will receive new spelling lists on a Friday to take home and learn. These will be tested on the following Friday.
