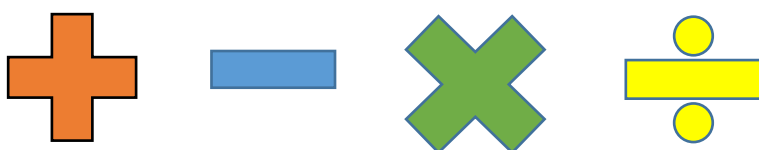
Maths
