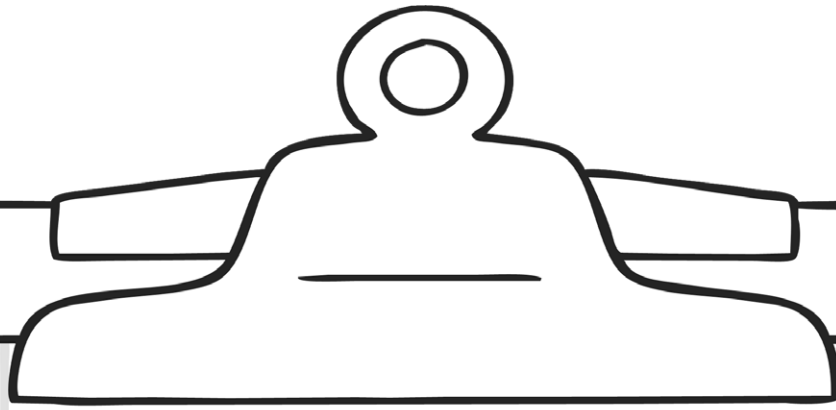

Fronted adverbials for when, where and how (e.g. Last year, Situated in the ocean, Slowly,)	
Rhetorical questions e.g. Have you ever wondered what it would be like without a mobile phone?	
Repetition for emphasis	
Conclusion to summarise and state opinion
